## Makeyourown BLUey Handbrum

## WHAT YOU NEED


- A clean cardboard tube container (e.g. stacking crisps, gravy granules, etc.)
- String (at least three times the diameter of the drum)
- Bluey characters to cut out and colour in (see next page)
- Beads
- Penci
- Scissors
- Coloured pape
- Sticky tape

- Ask a big person to cut out a 2.5cm section from the tube container. Make three holes around the ring two on the sides opposite each other and a larger one at the bottom for the pencil handle.
- Oraw around the ring on two pieces of coloured paper. Then draw another line roughly 1cm larger around the edge. Ask a grown up to help you cut the larger circles out. Make snips with the scissors from the outside circle to the inner one all around. Fold these tabs inwards.
- Spread glue around one edge of the cardboard ring. Place one of the paper circles over the glued side of the ring, press and stick the tabs down.
- Feed the string through the two side holes. Gently push the pencil through the larger bottom hole to reach the inside top edge. Secure the pencil inside the drum with tape or glue.
- **5** Take the second paper circle and glue to the other side of the cardboard ring as before.
- To neaten the outside edge, stick a length of tape around to cover the paper tabs. Make a little snip with your scissors on one side to go around the string and pencil (big people only please).
- Thread 2 or 3 beads on each side of the string and tie a knot on the ends. Make sure the beads reach the centre of the drum.
- Wind some coloured tape around the pencil handle to decorate and help keep it in place.
- **O** Print and colour in the Bluey pictures and stick them to the drum.
- To play the drum, hold the pencil and twist so that the beads hit the sides.
